RESCUE MISSON FOR CHILDREN

Our Miss Amelia and Miss Elaine recently spent some time at the Rescue Mission for Children in Thailand. Here is the story of one of the children named Namoo who they met on their trip...

It was 6 years ago when a beautiful little 3 years old was found by a village chief in a remote village of Myanmar. He requested the rescue mission manager to pick up a little girl named Namoo who was abandoned on the side of the road in a rice field by her nomadic parents. In this village and she was vulnerable to abuse, harm, human trafficking and starvation.

When Namoo was rescued she was naked, full of worms in her big swollen belly, scabies in her skin and parasites on her body. Her hair was light brown, very thin and wispy due to malnutrition.

When the manager picked her up (had to ask for clothes to cover her) and the poor little thing had never been in a car in her life, never met any of these strangers, she didn't cry or struggle just went in the car but wouldn't let anyone hold or comfort her.

When Namoo had been at the Rescue Mission for 3 months the change was remarkable, her hair thickened up and was glossy and black, her skin clear and a good colour, she was a healthy weight, lost her big swollen belly, and started to talk and

interact with the other children.

Namoo has been through so many challenges, She tended to over eat and then throw up due to her fear of being hungry. She also still suffers outbreaks of scabies and boils. Her teeth were so badly decayed she had to have extensive dental work when she was only 4-5 years old. She was also a bed wetter until recently so trauma was definitely an issue for her.

Today she is in Year 4, (she did 2 years of prep) aged 9 years, she is small for her age but healthy and happy, very clever and has a strong will and a beautiful smile.

Namoo has never seen her parents again since the day they abandoned her, therefore she is very grateful to the Rescue Mission and her sponsor for saving her life as she was a vulnerable girl who was at great risk of harm and abuse.

This is only 1 child of many heart breaking other stories from the Rescue Mission, that completely touched our hearts while over in Thailand. Miss Elaine and I will be continuing to support and help where is needed from Australia and we know this won't

be our last time over there.

4 YEAR OLD HEALTHY CHILD CHECKS

Don't forget to have your child seen by your GP or Child Health Clinic for their 4 year old healthy child check. You can have this check done anytime between 3.5yrs - 5yrs old. You will need to take along your child's personal health record book (their red book) to be filled in.

At this visit the Doctor or Nurse will make sure your child is on track for health and well being. It will include things like:

- height and weight
- eyesight hearing
- immunisation
- · oral health
- toileting
- allergies
